The Toolbox Series: Strategies for Coping & Building Strength

Toolbox Series

Last year, Leila da Costa, MFT, created a workshop based on her work at weSPARK and made clear the connection between cancer and trauma. In November, Lauren Maher, AMFT led an evening talk on our physiological response to anxiety and ways to combat it. The response to both of these workshops was overwhelming and our Toolbox Series was born.

In 2019, the Toolbox Series offers monthly workshops that will focus on four issues common to our guests - Pain Management, Stress Reduction, Anxiety and Trauma. Each workshop will be interactive and educational. Join us for the chance to pick up strategies and practices to deal with these issues in a handson, 90-minute workshop. These workshops are open to all weSPARK quests.

The Goal

A cancer diagnosis can leave patients feeling a loss of control, like cancer has the upper hand. How do you find peace when you're dealing with high amounts of stress? What impact does chronic pain have on fatigue levels? How do you build resilience when it feels like things are falling



apart? The Toolbox Series has been carefully designed so our guests have another way to tell their story, learn new techniques and feel empowered in their healing process.

We chose the areas of pain management, anxiety, trauma and stress reduction as a focus based on comments from the weSPARK community. By the end of the year, caregivers, patients and survivors will have a toolbox full of new strategies for coping and feeling stronger. For Caregivers: Tips for Navigating an Unpredictable Path

Caregivers very often become so focused on the patient's needs that they neglect their own. Experts say this is the most common, and most concerning, mistake caregivers can make. "Caregivers need to make sure they're eating, getting enough sleep and keeping up with their own medical appointments, because they can't help anyone if they're not well," Alexandria Callahan, LCPC, BC-DMT, GLCMA says. "It's the same as an emergency on an airplanewhen the oxygen mask comes down, you're supposed to put your mask on first. As caregivers, we jump at every single thing the patient needs and forget about ourselves. It's easier to focus externally than internally. It's cliché, but I tell people all the time to take a deep breath. It engages the diaphragm and forces you to focus on your breath and relaxes your body. You can take 30 seconds out of this crazy day and breathe while you're waiting for water to boil or you're at a red light or in the bathroom."

The first step is a Welcome meeting with one of our counselors. At this meeting guests learn more about our wrap-around approach to care, which includes support groups, classes and workshops and individual services.

SUPPORT GROUPS

Support groups are one part of the program that connects much of our community. We provide support groups for cancer patients at all stages, including specific groups for men, young adults, caregivers, children and those who are grieving. Groups meet weekly and are led by licensed clinicians.

CLASSES AND WORKSHOPS

Classes and workshops are created for the *weSPARK* community. Regular classes include yoga, Tai Chi, Mindful Living and Guided Imagery. Workshops focus on education and creative arts. Many of our movement classes have been designed specifically to address side effects such as chronic pain, neuropathy and balance issues.

INDIVIDUAL SERVICES

Healing therapies include Reiki, Qi Gong, Reflexology, Spiritual Counseling, Hypnotherapy, Ayurveda and Acupuncture. In addition, everyone is encouraged to meet with our Nurse Navigator and Nutritionist.

In 2018, *we*SPARK celebrated another successful year providing service and meeting goals! We continue to see increased guest participation with our wrap-around service model **Navigating Health Through Wellness**[®]. *we*SPARK continued to provide more than 11,000 services in 2018 with a steady number of new guests seeking services. Past and current guests as well as the medical community remain a consistent referral source for new guests. Outreach efforts resulted in an increase in building awareness in our community and established strong and solid partnerships with major hospitals, cancer centers and community organizations throughout Los Angeles.

Funding continues to come from diverse sources, including foundation grants, successful event fundraisers along with support from our Torchbearers and individual donors.






PROGRAM GROWTH

2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR-END INCOME




