In 2015, an estimated 1,658,370 new cases of cancer were diagnosed in the United States and 589,430 people died from the disease. We live in a world where literally everyone has been affected by cancer. With the expansive reach of cancer, weSPARK strives to continue to provide a supportive, hopeful, and welcoming healing environment to serve our community.

This past year, in response to a significant increase in new guests, we diversified our programs to be more inclusive, including more Spanish-speaking initiatives, a nurse navigator, a nutritionist, and a Doing Cancer Solo group where singles could learn to cultivate their own means of support. Our programs and services are provided free of charge and are designed to heal the mind, body, and spirit of all those whose lives have been affected by cancer.

WHAT WE DO

weSPARK offers over 40 free, ongoing classes and workshops delivered by expert facilitators, instructors, medical psychologists, social workers, and physical therapists to empower cancer patients with the educational, inspirational, and emotional tools to help them throughout their treatment and recovery process.

SUPPORT GROUPS

- Facilitated by a licensed clinical social worker or therapist
- Held in a safe, homelike setting for 90 minutes
- Serve patients who are in-treatment, post-treatment, and in ongoing treatment
- For family members, including caregivers, bereavement and children and teen groups

INTEGRATIVE COMPLEMENTARY THERAPIES

- Include Restorative and Gentle Yoga, Hypnotherapy, Reflexology, Acupressure, Reiki, Qi Gong, and Tai Chi
- Offer holistic aid for cancer patients
- Provide physical rehabilitation, stress reduction, pain management, anxiety management, and relaxation techniques

- Include Creative Writing, Guided Imagery, Jewelry Making, Mah Jongg, Music Workshops, Food Nutrition, and Mindfulness Meditation




