# Cut the Extra Sugars

By Cancer Treatment Centers of America®



What's the connection between sugar and cancer? Carolyn Lammersfeld, Vice President of Integrative Therapies at Cancer Treatment Centers of America® (CTCA) talks about possible outcomes associated with obesity. That's because excess sugars are not just empty calories; they also contribute to weight gain, which may in turn lead to obesity. With obesity linked to 13 types of cancer, watching your waistline is important for your health, not just your wardrobe.

"The main focus should be on lifestyle factors. Obesity links to poorer outcomes and a higher chance of recurrence if someone is diagnosed with cancer," says Lammersfeld, "I suggest people follow the same diet that we recommend to our patients—an anti-inflammatory diet that is mainly plant-based."

One way to cut back on sugars, according to Lammersfeld, is by following the **SLASH** plan:

**Stay in for meals:** Gain control by cooking at home and packing lunch and snacks.

**Look at labels:** Identify the difference between naturally occurring and added sugars on nutrition labels.

**Alternate sugar sources:** Use or make your own condiments and sauces without added sugar.

**Sweeten yourself:** Buy unsweetened products and sweeten them yourself to use less of any alternative sweetener.

**Hydrate:** Rethink what you are drinking and choose water more often.

"There are lots of healthy ways to feed your sweet tooth than by adding sugar to your diet," Lammersfeld says. "Fruits and vegetables contain antioxidants that can be important to protecting cells from the kind of damage that can lead to cancer and other diseases."

"It's all about making smarter choices and, when you do indulge in a sweet treat, just do it in moderation," Lammersfeld says. 🌈

As always, all services are completely free of charge to all our guests.

- Our community based programming includes monthly potlucks, jewelry workshops, Reiki circles, drum circles and so much more!

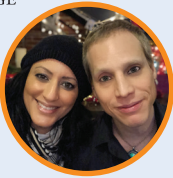

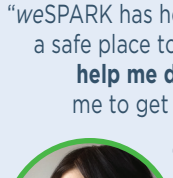

In 2017, weSPARK successfully met its programmatic and financial goals! We are thrilled to have increased retention and the participation of our wrap-around service model *Navigating Health Through Wellness<sup>SM</sup>*. weSPARK provided more than 11,000 individual services, which is a 24% increase from the prior year. We also saw a spike of 39.35% in new guest intakes from the prior year. This is due to individual referrals who have experienced our services, and an increase in building awareness in our community to establish strong and solid partnerships with major hospitals, cancer centers and community organizations throughout Los Angeles.

weSPARK is the beneficiary of a number of foundation grants, successful event fundraisers, along with support from our Torchbearers and individual donors. Approximately 78% of our overall expenses were allocated to Programs vs the industry standard of 65%; and approximately 7% of our overall expenses were allocated to Administrative vs the industry standard of 10%. 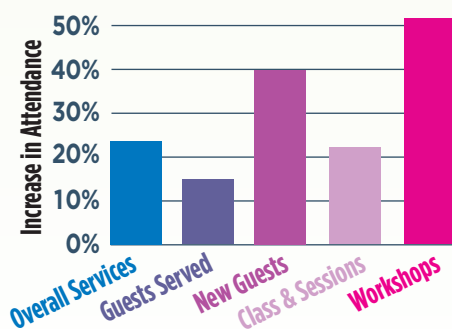

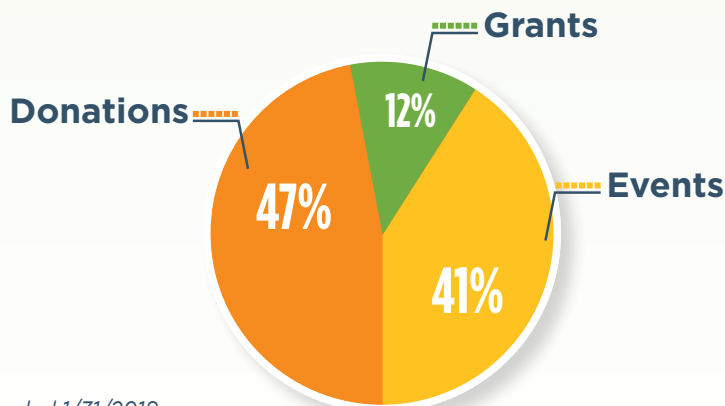
## PROGRAM GROWTH

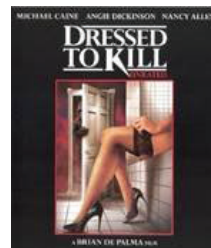
